








4. Friendly and welcoming community



Where can students access support?

- Academic tutor:
- Personal Learning Coach: to help with planning their time, organising their work, or any other issues that are preventing them from achieving their potential
- Homestay & Accommodation Officer: for any homestay family questions or issues.
- International Office: advice about bus passes, cultural visits and transition support.
- Counsellor: there is a free College counselling service.

Host Family Package


Included:

- Travel expenses college will organise a bus pass for every student at an additional cost




















New VISA Requirements

- Students travelling to study in the UK for 6 months or more will require a 'Student VISA'. This is applied for online via the Home Office website.
- The cost for the VISA is £348 this is paid online at the time of the application.
- You can apply for the VISA up to six months before the course start date.
- Usually, you will receive a decision within 6 weeks.








New VISA Requirements


- You can arrive in the UK up to 1 month before your course starts.
- You must pay a Health Surcharge of £470 to gain access to all NHS healthcare whilst in the UK.
